COLLEGE PROFILE

Established in the year 1965 as a co-ed institution, Pettigrew College prides itself on its 58 years of efficacious existence, making it the oldest college and the only government college in Ukhrul district to date. The college, as such, has long been committed to providing quality education in the higher education sphere of the region.

The rich legacy of the college can be traced back to the vision of the founders who were the educationists, public leaders and public at large of the Tangkhul community. Fondly named after Reverend William Pettigrew, the pioneer missionary who introduced education in the district, the college initially functioned as a private institution for 12 years before being taken over by the government of Manipur in 1977. The vision and mission of the founders to provide access to quality higher education particularly for the rural Tangkhul community, for them to become active participants in the changing and challenging world has since come a long way.

The college is dedicated to keeping pace with the progressive educational trends of higher education. It marches onward to realise and elevate the vision and values of the founders with the outstanding faculty of the college as the key strength, who are devoted to provide innovative educational opportunities, promote creativity and excellency into the students. Besides academic rigor, the college stresses on the employability skills of the students and offers a free short term course in Information Technology (IT) in addition to the core subjects, with the sole purpose of equipping and preparing students with the soft skills and technical skills vital in workplace and real-world situation.

NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020 (NEP 2020)

The NEP 2020 envisages a holistic and multidisciplinary education that aims to produce employable graduates with integrated personalities. The policy envisions the undergraduate degree to be either 3 to 4 years in duration, with multiple entry and exit options within this period.

CAMPUS FACILITIES

LIBRARY

The college has a well-stocked library where students and teachers can access texts from different disciplines. Periodicals subscribed by the college are also available in the library. Students can avail themselves of the facilities according to the library rules issued separately.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HOSTEL

The college provides hostel facilities separately fo both boys and girls. The hostels can accommodate up to 200 students (100 each for boys and girls). The mode of selection is based on a first-come first-served system.

The National Social Scheme (NSS) is well implemented in the college. NSS units, comprising both boys and girls, are engaged in various community services. It provides ample opportunities for organizing a number of activities which expose students to social services related to cleanliness, preservation of environment and social forestry.
