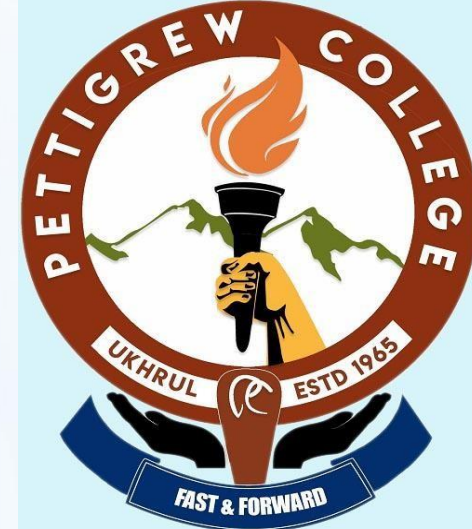

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I. COLLEGE PROFILE

Established in the year 1965 as a co-ed institution, Pettigrew College prides itself in its history of 54 efficacious years of existence, making it the oldest college and the only government college till date in Ukhrul district. The college, as such, has long been committed to providing quality education in the higher education sphere of the region.

The rich legacy of the college can be traced back to the vision of the founders who were the educationists, public leaders and public at large of the Tangkhul community. Fondly named after Reverend William Pettigrew, the pioneer missionary who introduced education in the district, the college initially functioned as a private institution for 12 years and was later on taken over by the government of Manipur in the year 1977. The vision and mission of the founders to provide access to quality higher education particularly for the rural Tangkhul community, for them to become active participants in the changing and challenging world has since then come a long way.

The college is dedicated to keep pace with the progressive educational trends of higher education. It marches onward to realize and elevate the vision and values of the founders with the outstanding faculty of the college as the key strength, who are devoted to provide innovative educational opportunities, promote creativity and excellency in the students. IV. ADMISSION GUIDELINE & INFORMATION

Admissions in this college are made on the basis of rule framed by the college admission committee as per the University ordinance. For admission, the college recognizes only the Public examination of council/Boards and Universities.

Minimum Qualification

- Candidates seeking admission to B.A 1st Semester under the faculty of Arts should have passed the class XII examination (Arts/Science) securing at least 45% of marks for General Candidates and 40% of marks for reserved candidates.
- Candidates seeking admission to BSc 1st Semester should have passed the class XII examination in science stream securing at least 45% of marks for General Candidates and 40% of marks for reserved candidates.

Documents for Admission

- (a) Attested copies of Mark Sheets, Admit cards and Provisional Certificates of HSLC/Matriculation and HSE.
- (b) Character Certificate from the School/College last attended.
- (c) Caste/Tribe Certificate issued by the concerned authority for candidates belonging to the scheduled Caste/Tribe.
- (d) Four recent passport size photographs.

* The original copy of the documents/enclosures should be produced at the time of admission for verification purposes.

Important Information and Rules

- The duly filled in prescribed admission form enclosed in the prospectus along with the relevant documents should be submitted to the college admission counter on or before the last date of submission.
- Separate application form is to be submitted if seeking admission in more than one subject combination.
- Incomplete application forms shall be rejected.
- Under no circumstances forms shall be received after the last date.
- All admissions are provisional.
- The admission of a candidate shall be cancelled if it is found, at any stage;
 - i. Not fulfilling the eligibility requirements.
 - ii. Had used fraudulent means to secure admission.
 - iii. Made false or incorrect statements.

V. CAMPUS FACILITIES

Library: The college has a well-stocked library where students and teachers can have access to texts of different disciplines. Periodicals subscribed by the college are also available in the library. Students can avail the facilities as per the library rules issued separately.

Hostel: The college provides hostel facilities separately for both boys and girls. The hostels can accommodate up to 100 students. Deserving students can avail concession of fees by paying a meagre registration fee of Rs 500/-only per academic session. The mode of selection is done on the basis of first come first serve system.

Canteen: The college has a canteen within its premise. It is open during office hours to meet the refreshment needs of the staffs and students of the college.

NSS: The National Social Scheme (NSS) is well implemented in the college. NSS units comprising of both boys and girls are engaged in various community services. It provides ample opportunities of organizing a number of activities which exposes students to social services related to cleanliness, preservation of environment and

social forestry.

Games and Sports: Facilities for games and sports both indoor and outdoor are available in the college. The college has a spacious football ground, fields and provisions for a number of other games like volley ball, table tennis and badminton. The college Sports Meet is held annually in the college campus.

Students' Union: The students are given a platform to enhance the leadership qualities by allowing them to form a Students' Union with its office bearers elected annually as per the guidelines issued by the college authority. The Union functions for the welfare of the students' community in particular and the college in general.

Gym: Well-equipped in-house gymnasium with latest machines and exercise equipment's are available within the college campus for the students as well as faculty. Students are encouraged to use the facility to enhance their physical fitness and hone their physique. The gym provides an ideal opportunity who otherwise cannot have access to such facilities.

Laboratories: The college has individually designed and well equipped Laboratory facilities of various Departments for both Arts and Science streams.

- **Arts:** Geography Lab, Education Lab.
- **Science:** Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Botany Lab, Zoology Lab.

Computer Lab: The college has over 30 computers to meet the students Information Technology needs. Trained and experienced teachers provide both theoretical and practical lessons for students to help them navigate a changing technology driven world. The room is also equipped with audio visual teaching aids and acts as an audio visual teaching room for teachers to deliver lessons and educational films whenever necessary.

VI. GENERAL INFORMATION

Discipline:

- Students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline in all spheres of activities in the college. They should follow the rules and regulations prescribed by the college authority from time to time.
