

44 Ukhurul ST MLA Assures Support for Strengthening Higher Education at Pettigrew College



Ukhurul, July 30: The 44 Ukhurul ST MLA, **Shri Ramnganing Muivah**, visited Pettigrew College, Ukhurul, and interacted with the faculty members to discuss the development of higher education in the district.
